MMWEC scholarships awarded to Jing Yan and Kaitlyn Vitorino

LUDLOW, Mass. – May 7, 2007 – The Massachusetts Municipal Wholesale Electric Company (MMWEC) has awarded \$1,000 scholarships to Jing Yan and Kaitlyn Vitorino, members of the Ludlow High School (LHS) Class of 2007.

MMWEC annually awards two \$1,000 scholarships to LHS graduates pursuing a college education in engineering, environmental sciences, finance or accounting.

Yan is planning to pursue a degree in Accounting at Bridgewater State College. A native of Beijing, China, Yan moved to the United States and entered LHS in September 2005. During high school, she has been a track team participant and a member of the Math Club, the Music Club and the Physics Club. Yan has maintained a high grade point average and is described by her guidance counselor as “a very determined young woman” who “is destined for high academic achievement.”

Vitorino is planning to pursue a degree in Architectural Engineering at the University of Hartford. She is a consistent honor roll student and is a recipient of the John & Abigail Adams MCAS Award. In addition, Vitorino has been a Varsity Cheerleader, a member of the Portuguese Club and a Talent Show participant. She is described by her guidance counselor as having “an exceptional record for academic and extra-curricular achievement” and as “an excellent representative of her school and community”.

Yan and Vitorino were chosen as recipients of the MMWEC scholarships based on their strong academic and extracurricular achievements as well as their commitment to pursue educational paths that could lead to a career in the utility industry.

As part of its commitment to the Ludlow community, MMWEC has awarded \$18,000 in scholarships to help LHS students defray the cost of higher education since the inception of the scholarship program in 1998.

MMWEC is a non-profit, public corporation that provides a variety of electric power supply, financial and other services to the Commonwealth’s consumer-owned municipal utilities. MMWEC is the operator and principal owner of the Stony Brook power plant on Moody Street and has been a corporate resident of Ludlow for nearly 30 years.
