- Fulfill all Forward Capacity Market (FCM) related reporting requirements and obligations
- Execute all Forward Reserve Market (FRM) related reporting requirements and obligations for Member Systems
- Oversee Assigned Portfolios of Power Costs Reports, Power Cost Forecasts and Asset Performance Reports of Member Systems
- Acts as an advocate of MMWEC's plans, policies, and procedures with the company and when representing the company at meetings and other functions. (S)he is responsible for adhering to industry standards as applicable
- Perform daily rotational duties
